THE SIZE AND THE SCOPE OF THE JOB

Around 1.9million people mainly live in the urban centres and towns across Hampshire, Portsmouth, Southampton and the Isle of Wight. While the vast majority of the population live in urban areas, there is also a large rural area. 15 local authorities and 19 MPs serve and govern the county and its districts and boroughs.





DELIVERING THE POLICE AND CRIME PLAN

My Police and Crime Plan provides the strategic approach that I will take as Commissioner. The Delivery Plan that flows from this strategic plan sets out the detailed approach to delivering my plan, including the intended outcomes and the measurements to assess them. The Delivery Plan will also determine how the budget is allocated and the decisions I will take.




FUNDING FORMULA

The budget for the Police and Crime Commissioner and Hampshire Constabulary principally comes from two sources. In Hampshire two thirds come from Government grants and the remaining third comes from the Council Tax precept, which is set locally by the Commissioner.


Of the overall budget of £305 million, £284.42 million is provided directly to Hampshire Constabulary (2016/17 figures). The budget provision will be reviewed annually, taking into account the priorities and principles set out in my Police and Crime Plan.

- Sets the budget and council tax precept
- Owns and is responsible for all Police assets (i.e. Buildings, equipment and vehicles)
- Hires and (if necessary) fires the Chief Constable
- Holds the Chief Constable to account for performance of the Police Force
