Bitterne Shed Club	The Bitterne Shed Club is a community project and craft workshop for older, isolated men. It has purchased a new 'Shed' – an old shipping container – which is being fitted out with utilities by members. The location has previously been targeted by vandals. This funding would be used to purchase security equipment.	£466.80
Hamble Allotments	To buy locks and security chains to reduce the vandalism on Hamble Allotments experienced since a path and route through the allotments was approved.	£100
Citizens Advice Bureau Gosport	Promotion of how to avoid becoming a victim of a scam. The funding would contribute towards the printing and delivery costs of an information leaflet to be distributed in every home in Gosport.	£160
Sarisbury Green Community Centre	The Centre has been in operation over 70 years, but unfortunately has seen an increase in vandalism during lockdown. This funding will be used towards installing new CCTV cameras to act as a deterrent to vandals and increase staff protection.	£500

Unity (Southern) Ltd	We are requesting a grant for Unity Youth, a young-people-based Unity service, aimed to find out about the young people in our area and what they think, creating a forum for positive change and discussion. We would like to run an awareness campaign, based on social media, to inform young people to stay safe during the Coronavirus. We will also like to use it to survey young people within the Test Valley secondary schools about what their experience with the pandemic. The funding would pay for social media advertising, leaflets and promotional materials, developing a survey for all secondary pupils in the Borough, and printing and distributing findings.	£500
The Carroll Centre	We are seeking funding to buy a computer which will be used to help us develop a project that will support vulnerable community members that are already socially or economically disadvantaged. The computer will enable us to provide training for working in small scale manufacturing and the online service industry and give an opportunity to gain skills in an employment area that has proven more robust in the current economic environment.	£500

Our clients are largely drawn from BAME ethnicities and are substantially more vulnerable to Covid-19 infection. In order to re-open our James Street Centre office in September, we must enforce strict rules on social distancing and hygiene which involves a much higher level of cleaning.
