The aims of the Youth Commission are to:

- Identify three priority areas relating to young people around police and crime
- Consult young people on our priorities through the 'Big Conversation'
- Link with Hampshire Constabulary and Criminal Justice partners
- Attend events and tackle the three priorities by raising awareness
- Create exciting campaigns
- Represent the Youth Commission at relevant events, conferences and meetings
- Share views with professionals by making recommendations for change and suggesting solutions
