Fuel card contract

Executive summary

The request is to amend decision 202 to put a new contract in place for the provision of fuel cards. The new contract will last for 2 years with the option to extend for up to a further 3 years, subject to agreement on an annual basis i.e. 2 years +1year +1year +1year.

The maximum contract value over the maximum 5 year term is £15m, based on annual estimated expenditure of approximately £2.6m in the current financial year. The funding is already built into the budget for the current financial year and rolled forward for future years in the Medium Term Financial Strategy so there is no increase in budget required. A PCC decision is requested due to the value of the new contract.

Recommendation(s)

It is recommended that approval is given to enter into a fuel card contract for 2 years with an option to extend by +1year +1year +1year (i.e. a maximum of 5 years) at a maximum contract value of £15m.
