## **Dear Parents and Carers**

I am writing to you from the Violence Reduction Partnership about the national knife crime awareness campaign, Operation Sceptre, from  $13^{th} - 19^{th}$  May 2024, to help tackle knife crime.

This week, there will be activities, including police operations, surrender bins, education and talks for children. We educate children they are safer not carrying knives, and help them walk away from dangerous situations.

Very few young people carry knives, but when it happens, knife crime has devastating impacts. As a partnership, we work hard to deter people from carrying knives. It is against the law to carry a knife for your protection. We are asking all parents and carers to talk to children about this issue and seek help if you are worried. It is unlikely that your child is carrying a knife, but perhaps they know someone who does. Here are some useful resources which can help:
