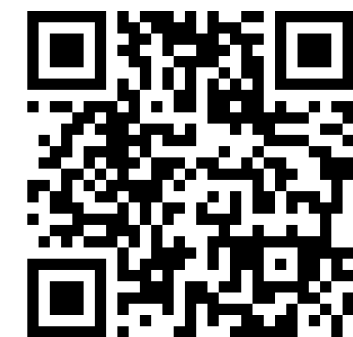
SAFE4ME
