Decision title

Funding for Fixed Camera Enforcements Solutions across Hampshire and the Isle of Wight:

Phase One - A2030 Eastern Road, Portsmouth – Fixed Camera Speed Enforcement Solution.

Executive summary

Road Safety, including speeding issues is a key concern for the communities of Hampshire and the Isle of Wight. This Decision Request details how the Safer Roads Unit (SRU) proposes to contribute to reducing the number of fatalities, injuries and collisions on our roads.

- An incremental strategy to identify, install and embed four fixed enforcement solutions across Hampshire and the Isle Wight.
- This decision request specifically focusses on phase one of this four-part proposal only.
- Phase One – to address the higher care site and offending rates identified on the A2030 Eastern Road, Portsmouth.
- The timeline for implementation of this phase is approximately nine months.
- The funding request for phase one implementation is £40,000, plus an ongoing annual cost of £5,000 for servicing and maintenance.

Recommendation

It is recommended that a one off cost of £40,000, plus a recurring annual cost of £5,000 for servicing and maintenance is allocated from the Safer Roads Reserve Fund to enable Hampshire & Isle of Wight Constabulary to re-purpose and re-locate existing currently unused fixed housings and camera enforcement assets, already owned by Hampshire and Isle of Wight Constabulary at the A2030 Eastern Road, Portsmouth.

It is recommended that police begin phase two concurrently with further decision requests submitted at appropriate points throughout the implementation of the strategy.
