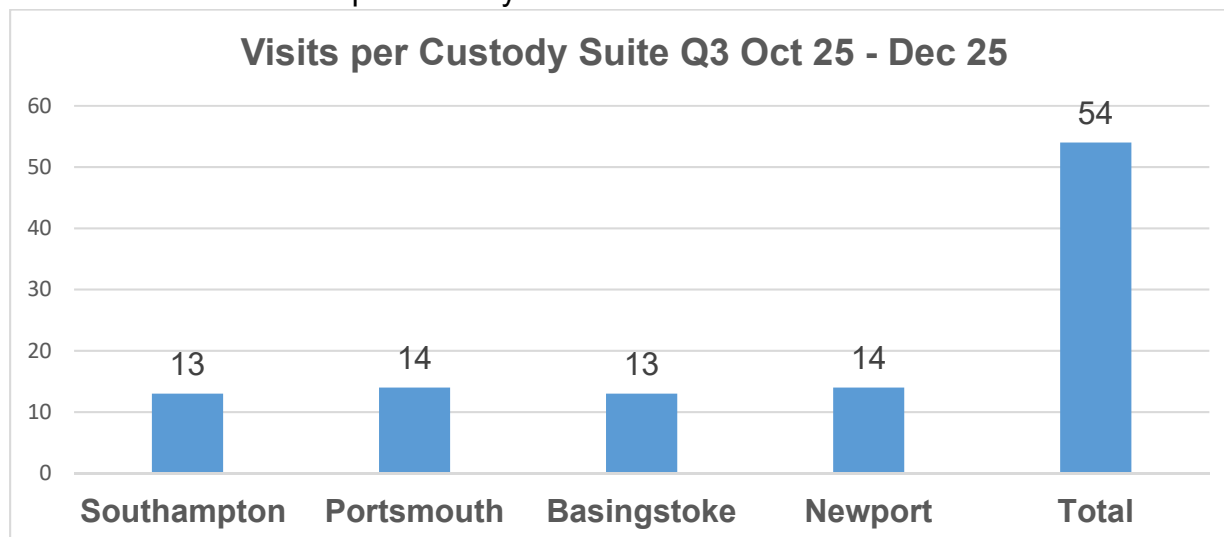


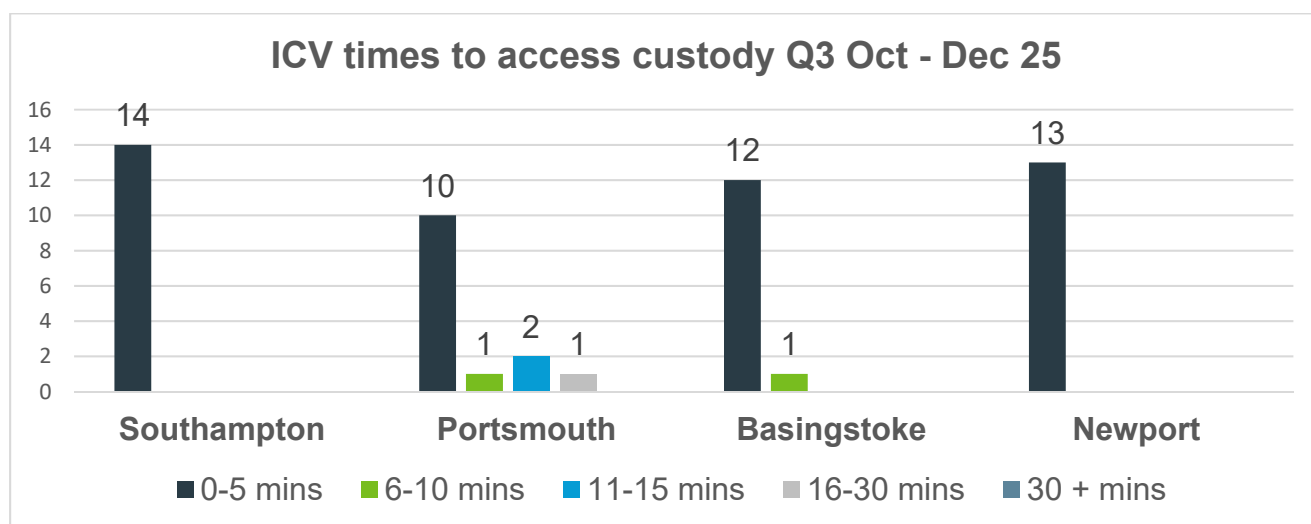
## ICV Quarterly Report October – December 2025

**Overview:** This report is to provide information about visits undertaken by Independent Custody Visitors (ICVs) between 1<sup>st</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025.

**Visits:** Visit forms have been received for a total of 54 visits for the period. Outlined below are the number of visits per custody suite.



**Access to Custody Suites:** The following table outlines information on the time taken for ICVs to gain access to custody suites once contacted. This is useful for identifying any emerging patterns of delay.



**Day and Time of Visits:** The chart below outlined the day and period of the week when visits were undertaken between 1<sup>st</sup> October – 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025:

**Detainees interviewed, observed and not seen by ICVs:** The following table highlights the number of detainees who were interviewed, observed and not seen, due to being unavailable, by ICVs between 1st October to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025:

- ICVs witnessed the calm manner from a Sgt dealing with a very aggressive detainee who was kicking the door of cell. The officer was assertive but calmly dealt with the detainee.

### Examples of where ICVs have affected change

- ICVs visited a detainee who had hurt their foot and after speaking to the detainee, ICVs were able to get the detainee access to a wheelchair.
